The Production Accountant will track daily production, collect traceability documents, and create bills of lading. Before the start of production, and at any down times during the season, the Production Accountant may be assigned other office duties, such as data entry and filing. This is a seasonal position working approximately May-August. Due to the seasonal nature of our industry, the Production Associate works approximately 12 hours per day, seven days per week during peak production seasons approximately. This position is hourly and reports to the Plant Manager and Office Manager.
